Five Acres was incorporated in 1888. We are the oldest in San Gabriel Valley. Five Acres started as an all boys orphanage serving 45 children each year.

Our first site was located in downtown LA on Hubbard Street and our original legal name was The Boys and Girls Aid Society of Los Angeles.



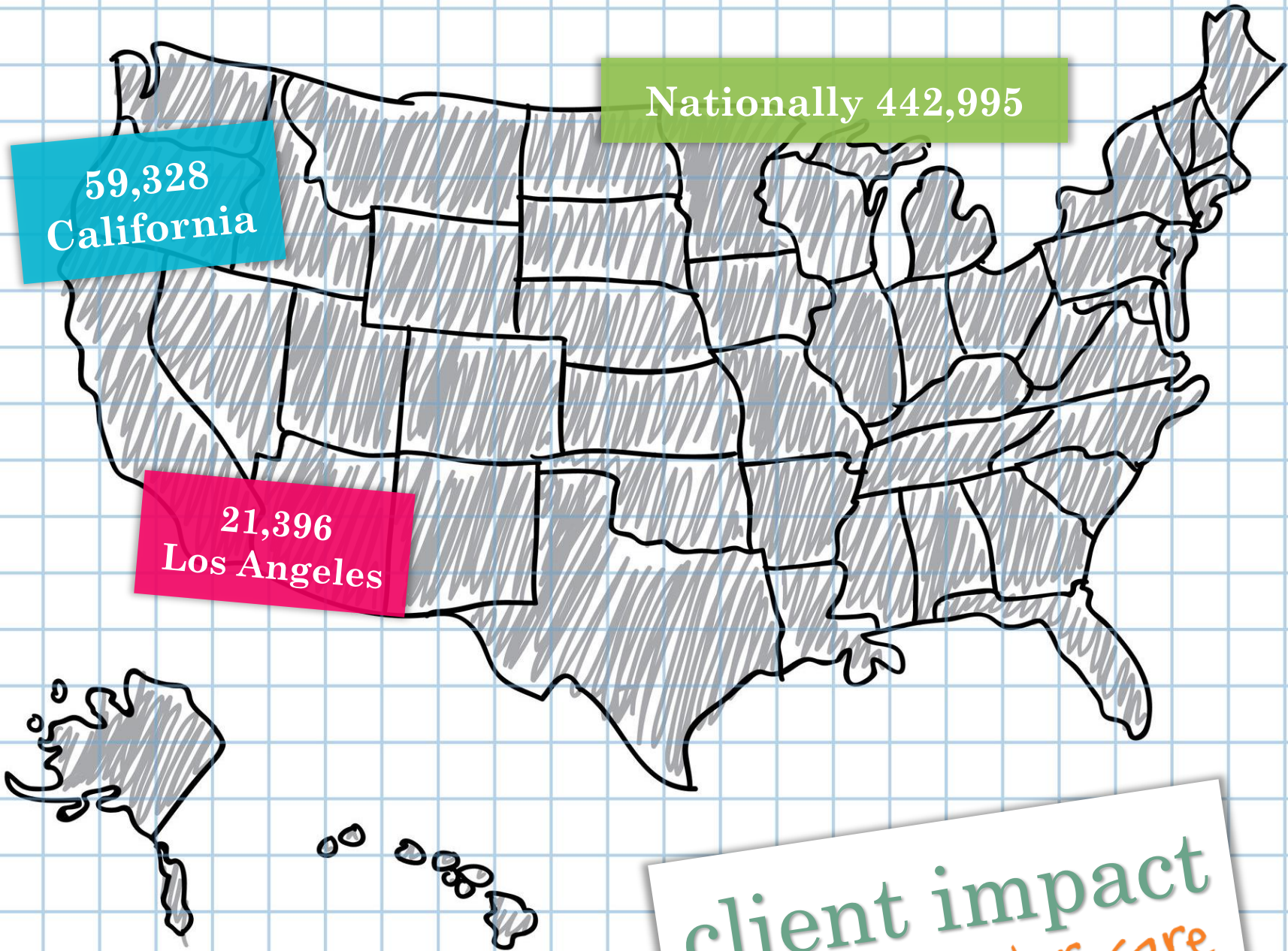
Five Acres was added to our legal name when the board of directors purchased the five acres of land to build the main campus.

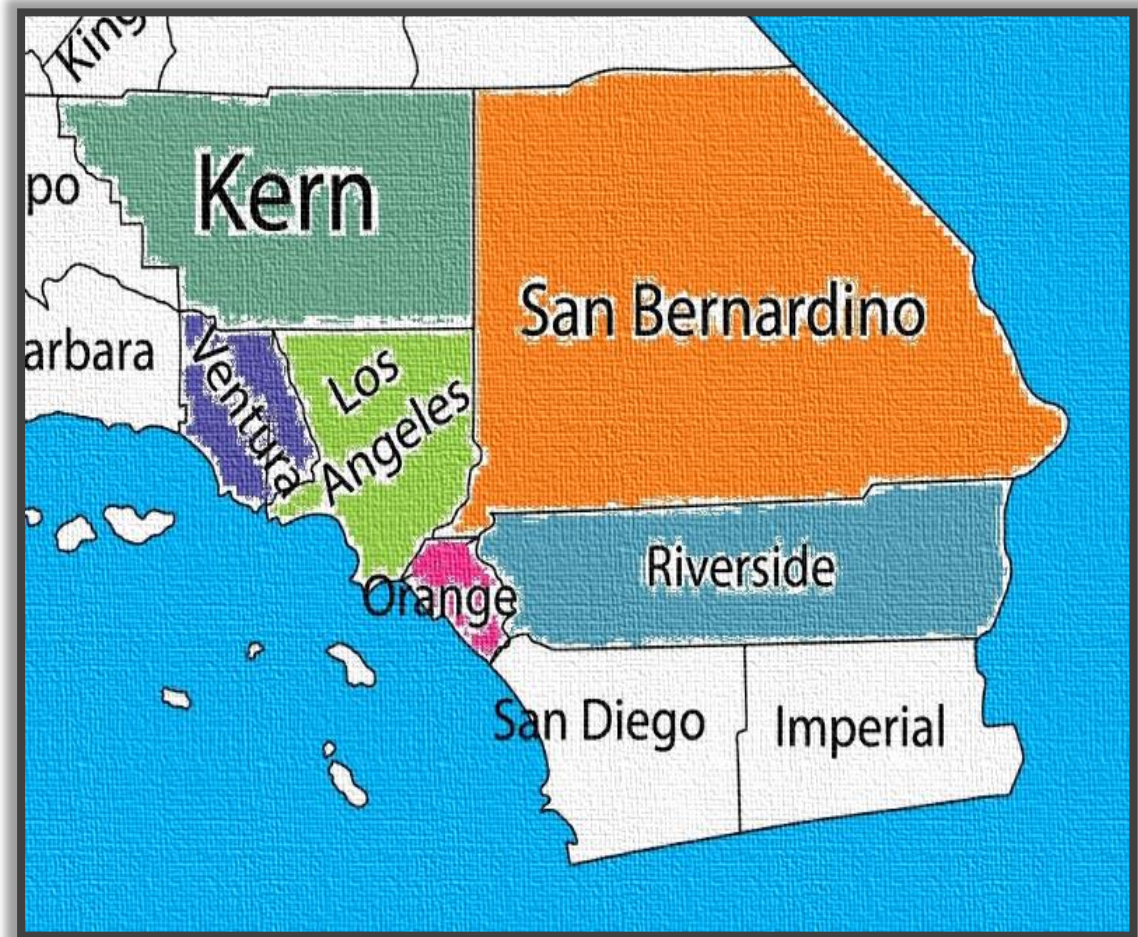

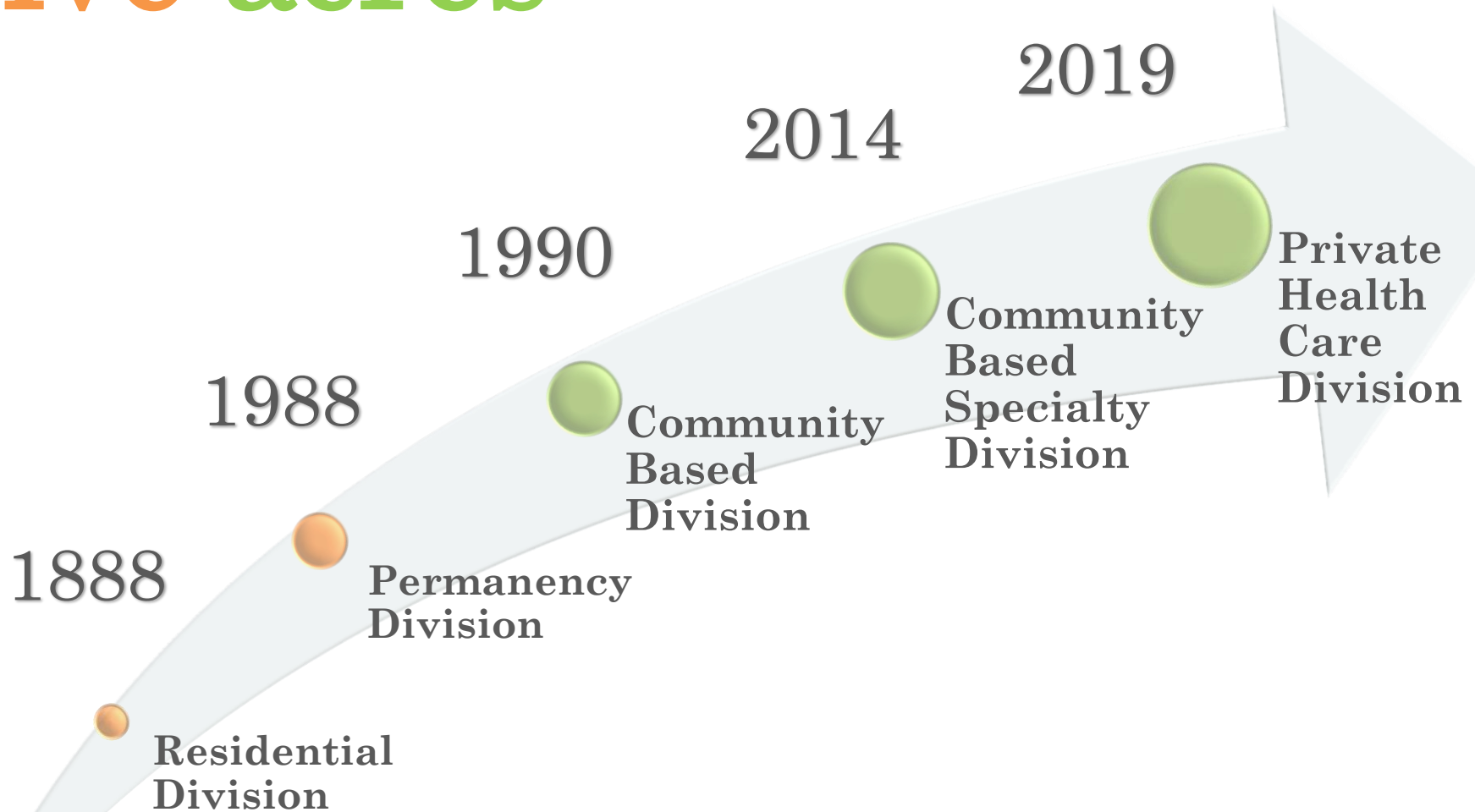

How many children and families did we impact and where?

Five Acres continues to serve vulnerable children and families. In 2019-2020, we impacted the lives of 9,081 children and their families across six counties.

Intervention - A child has been impacted by abuse and neglect. Helping children to improve their wellbeing and to find permanency. Clients are usually in the foster care system.

Prevention - Preventing child abuse and neglect. Helping children sustain wellbeing and permanency within their family and their community. Clients usually live with a family.



81% of the children we served were discharged with a permanent family solution

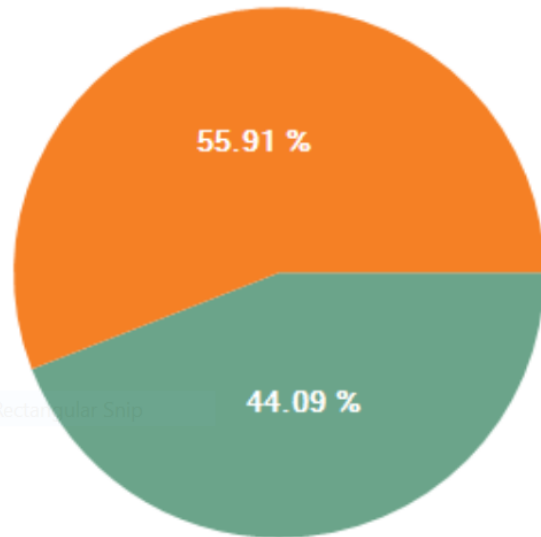
Short Term Residential Therapeutic Program

We believe every child should be raised by a loving family. Yet, when a child experiences acute trauma at home, living outside the home and within residential care is sometimes the best place to support children and families during the reunification process. At Five Acres, we provide Short Term Residential Therapeutic Programs for these children to restore balance, rebuild trust and reunify them with their families or connect them to loving foster-adopt families.

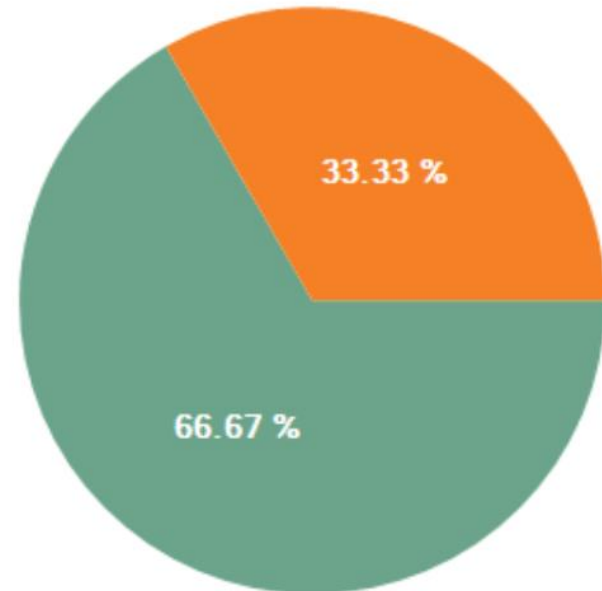
Short Term Residential Therapeutic Program *Population in 19/20*

Short Term Residential Therapeutic Program *Services*

Services are provided by a multidisciplinary team that includes:

- Clinician
- Psychiatrist
- Case Manager
- Residential Treatment Counselors
- Crisis Intervention Specialists
- Behavioral Specialists

We also work and partner with the Department of Children and Family Services, Department of Mental Health, Law Enforcement and sister agencies.
