




History of Altadena Michele Zack


- Michele is a writer, historian, and activist and author of Altadena: Between Wilderness and City.

Altadena Town Council Brief History & Overview

HOW WAS THE ALTADENA TOWN COUNCIL (ATC) ESTABLISHED?

- Established 47 years ago in November 1975
- With the help of the League of Women Voters - Pasadena Chapter
- First election October 11-12, 1975
- 1,500 ballots were cast
- Unpaid, volunteer council and committees

WHY DO WE NEED A TOWN COUNCIL?

- Altadena is an unincorporated area in L.A. County
- Facilitates two-way dialogue with government local, state and federal
- Establishes a forum for residents to discuss and resolve community issues
- Allows representatives to work with local organizations for the betterment of Altadena
- ATC Land Use can review and provide feedback for development plans, including informing conditional use permits

WHO IS THE TOWN COUNCIL?

- There are 8 census tracts in Altadena
- Each census tract selects two representatives via election
- These representatives are members of the community, volunteering their time






