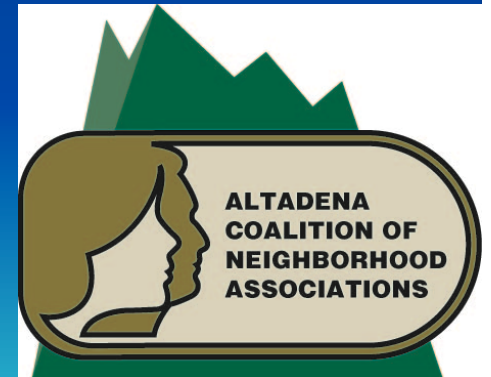

# An Unmanned Aircraft is an Aircraft that Must Comply with Safety Requirements

- (1) Capable of sustained flight in the atmosphere;
- (2) Flown within visual line of sight of the person operating the aircraft; and
- (3) Flown for hobby or recreational purposes.

Flight restrictions are used to protect, but are not limited to, special security events, sensitive operations (e.g., select Law Enforcement activity, space flight operations, JPL, Rose Bowl, Parades), and Presidential movement. The most up-to-date list of TFRs is available at

# Commercial and Other Non-Model Aircraft UAS Operations

- 1) **14 C.F.R. Part 107**: The new regulatory framework enables certain small UAS operations for commercial and other non-hobby purposes. The rule addresses airspace restrictions, remote pilot certification, and operational limits. Read the full regulation at:

# New laws starting January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017

AB1680 – Makes it a misdemeanor to interfere with first responders or emergency personnel at the scene of an emergency.



## New laws starting January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017

AB1680 – Makes it a misdemeanor to interfere with first responders or emergency personnel at the scene of an emergency.

SB807 – Protects emergency first responders from liability for damage to a drone that is interfering with the responder's ability to provide emergency service.





## LA Co. Sheriff's Department

- Used in search-and-rescue,
- bomb detection,
- hostage situations and other critical incidents
- LASD responds to approximately 125 hazmat situations, 600 suspicious or unattended package and/or device calls, 500 arson/explosives situations, and 500 search and rescue operations per year.
- Own 3 UAV, 2 for training and 1 for deployment. Cost of \$10,000.



Should homeowners be allowed to exclude drones from airspace above their property? Does it matter if the drone is flying ten feet above the ground or 100 feet above the ground? Clearly, homeowners cannot prohibit airplanes from flying overhead.



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Federal law authorizes flight within “navigable airspace,” usually defined as above 400 feet. Property owners can prohibit trespassing on the surface of their land. But there is presently no legal clarity as to property rights in the airspace in which a drone traditionally operates.



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It is not legal for a person to record private property below where a UAV is flying. In California, recording someone with a drone is not a criminal violation, but a civil one. Prosecution starts by identifying the drone and the person being the remote.
