



Announcing BraeWatch

Neighborhood Watch for residents of Braeburn Road and surrounding homes.

Hello Neighbor,

In response to the continuing wave of daytime and nighttime burglaries and robberies in our neighborhood, Braeburn area residents have consulted with detectives at the Altadena Sheriffs' station and have created:

BraeWatch Neighborhood Watch Web Site: www.BraeWatch.org is a password protected web site for use by verified local residents only. This site includes a blog used by area residents to share alerts and information regarding security in our neighborhood. Altadena Sheriff detectives also contribute notices, alerts and advice to BraeWatch.

BraeWatch Emergency Contact List: by and for Braeburn area residents, allows local residents to instantly notify any neighbor (at home or at work) of suspicious activity or crimes in progress. The List also permits instant email broadcast of emergency notifications to all Braeburn area residents simultaneously in the event of criminal activity or natural disasters. Many residents have already submitted their contact info, and as a Braeburn-area resident you have the option to request that your contact information also be included in this list.

The Sheriff advises that the first step in reducing and preventing crime in our area is to be alert, be observant and to **ACTIVELY COMMUNICATE** with each other and with the Sheriff. Following that advice, we've established the BraeWatch web site and contact list as an efficient, free, real-time communication vehicle for all area residents.

Over 40 of your neighbors have already registered with BraeWatch.org. Once all residents have had an adequate opportunity to register and gain access to the site and blog, we will be working with the Altadena Sheriffs' Station to proceed with reviving the Neighborhood Watch program in our area.



➔ Attempted Burglary On La Solana May 31

Neighbor Bob Essick on La Solana reports that someone attempted to enter his home just before 2:30am on May 31, by slicing his front window screen. He was awoken by the sound of his water main valve turning off. He opened his garage door, scaring off the would-be burglar. He believes that the burglar accidentally turned off the water valve, which is at ground level next to the window at the front of his home. The Sheriff was called, and the event now appears on crimereports.com. Thanks to Bob for sharing this information, and to Diane Horwitz for sending in the report.

FRIDAY, JUNE 25, 2010

→ Four Burglaries In The Neighborhood Today

Our friends at [Altadenablog](#) (BraeWatch members) report that in addition to the burglary mentioned by Captain McLean, 3 additional burglary events occurred in our area today -- on New York, Santa Rosa and Layton Street. Windows were broken and doors kicked in to gain access. An alert neighbor reported hearing the sound of a door being kicked in on New York. One homeowner reported a seeing a teen walking with a backpack while talking on a cell phone just prior to a burglary. 

Is this thing legit?

BraeWatch is just a large group of your neighbors collaborating to reduce crime in the area, under the advisement of law enforcement. There are Altadena Sheriff's detectives and Sheriff's Community Advisory Council representatives monitoring and participating in the BraeWatch blog. There is no advertising on the blog and no purpose for the blog other than to empower local residents to reduce crime. If you have concerns, you are welcome to contact the Sheriff's station and ask for BraeWatch member Lt. Sanchez.

Who owns BraeWatch? All residents of the [Braeburn Area](#).

What the heck is the "Braeburn Area?" The [area covered by BraeWatch](#) does not conform to any specific existing named area of Altadena. Braeburn Road cuts roughly through the center and spans the width of the area. Hence the nickname "Braeburn Area" and the blog name "BraeWatch."

Am I eligible to participate?

Participation is limited to verified residents of a particular area of east Altadena nicknamed "the Braeburn Area." as defined on [this map](#). Residents are verified using [publically available LA County online tax records listing your name and address](#). The Braeburn Area may expand in the future, but is already very large for a neighborhood watch group, with hundreds of homes included. We encourage the formation of sister neighborhood watch groups in Altadena and we are committed to support and work in partnership with all such groups.

Does anyone make money from BraeWatch? That would be swell, but no. BraeWatch is a free resource, and advertising is not permitted on the blog. Hopefully the burglars will make LESS money as the result of BraeWatch.

I don't understand "blogs." Can I receive BraeWatch information by email? Yes. After you complete the registration process, you can subscribe to receive information and alerts by email, and need not re-visit or use the blog. But you are welcome to post alerts and info to the blog at any time.

A private contact list, accessible only to verified Braeburn area residents who are BraeWatch members. Supplying your contact information will enable any neighbor to notify you at home, work or cell to report suspicious activity on or around your property. Also supports real-time emergency alert email broadcasts and neighbor phone trees during natural disasters and other major events. Contact information is otherwise confidential and will be used only for emergency notifications and alerts. If you submit this form and are not yet registered to participate in the BraeWatch blog, you will be sent an email invitation to register for the blog as well, typically within 24-48 hours.







What is a listserve?

- What is a listserve?
 - A listserve (aka newsgroup) is basically an email distribution list.
 - A listserve enables subscribers to communicate with each other through one email address.
 - There are many free newsgroups (e.g. Yahoo, Google, etc).
 - The McNally and Cheney Trail NW Groups use Yahoo! Groups.
 - The McNally and Chaney Trail listserve were a key source of real-time information during the Station Fire.
 - Altadenablog.com
- What is a Yahoo! Group?
 - A Yahoo! Group is any group — your family, friends you see every summer, business associates, your book group, etc. — that uses Yahoo! Groups to privately share email, info, images, ideas and more — on the web.
 - If you have a yahoo email account, you can utilize the additional features of the newsgroup (e.g. add/post calendar items, event reminders, photos, files, links, etc).
 - The McNally Listserve is a Yahoo! Group.
- How much does it cost to create/join a Yahoo! Group?
 - There is no cost to creating/joining a Yahoo! Group.
- Do I need any special software to use Yahoo! Groups?
 - No, nothing special. To subscribe to Yahoo! Groups, all you need is Internet access and an email address.

Joining a listserve

- How do I join Yahoo! Groups?
 - You can create a new Yahoo! Group at groups.yahoo.com
 - Yahoo! Group info at:
<http://help.yahoo.com/l/us/yahoo/groups/original/members/index.html>
 - To join an existing Yahoo! Group, submit a request by emailing <groupname>-subscribe@yahoogroups.com.
 - The moderator can also manually add you to the existing Yahoo! Group.
- Do I need a Yahoo! email address to use Yahoo! Groups?
 - No, you can use any email address you'd like. Keep in mind that your email address will be visible to the owner/moderators of the groups you join. If you post a message, other members of the listserve group will receive your email. Make sure you use an email address which you don't mind disclosing to them.
 - Please note that if you are using a non-yahoo email address, you will not be able to utilize the additional features of the newsgroup (e.g. add/post calendar items, event reminders, photos, files, links, etc).

How do I post a message/email to the Mcnally listserve?

- Send an email to mcnally-nw@yahoogroups.com
- Please note that anyone that is not subscribed to the Mcnally listserve **CANNOT** send or receive emails to the group.
- Email mcnally-nw-subscribe@yahoogroups.com Please ensure that you provide information about yourself when requesting to be added to the listserve. This will help speed the process when verifying your information.
- Your request will be forwarded to the moderator and you will be added once your information has been verified. The moderator may also add you directly to the listserve if your email was provided (e.g. at the Neighborhood Watch Meetings).



Privacy, Members, and Identity

Who will see my emails to the Yahoo! Group?

- This is a private email group. Anyone that is not subscribed to this email group cannot send or receive emails within the group. New users to the group (pending verification) can ONLY be added by the moderator.
- Message posts within the Yahoo! Group will not be indexed by search engines.
- We may forward emails from other listserves that are available for cross-posting [e.g. Cheney Trail] to the Mcnally listserve.

What information is publicized when I participate in Yahoo! Groups?

- If you post a message — which sends each Group member an email — your entire email address is shown in the "From:" field, just as if you were sending them email directly.

My email address is being revealed

- In email messages that member receive, your email address will display in full to all members who receive the email (just as if you sent the email directly to each member). We do this so that members who receive emails have the option of replying directly to you versus emailing the entire group.
- You can hide your Yahoo! ID by creating an alias within Yahoo! Pulse.

What information can I see about other members?

- Members who associate their account with a Yahoo! ID show whatever information they've made public within their Yahoo! profile.
